

Summary of Changes to Florida SHOTS Release 10.3.7

This release is carry-over from Release 10.3.6. Below information explains final functionality. Restriction on entering Part B expiration dates (when allowed) greater than one year in the future has been removed. Part B's are still blocked in cases where all series except DTAP are complete, DTAP is up to date, and only one dose remains to be administered in the DTAP series (the TDAP booster or equivalent).

Changes Affecting All Users

- 680 Part B blocking implemented in Release 10.3.5 updated to only block creation of Part B when all series but DTAP is complete, DTAP series is up to date, there is only one dose left to receive in the DTAP series, and the recommended due date for that dose + 15 days is more than 1 year in the future.
- 680 Part B option also updated such that, in cases where a default date is supplied by the system, if that date would otherwise be more than 1 year in the future, the date field would instead be left blank for user entry. Users may still edit any date which may be populated in that field.
