

Summary of Changes to Florida SHOTS Release 2018.1

New updates affecting all (or most) users:

- Organization names now allowed to be longer than 30 characters (service site name length was extended in a previous update)
- Provider Person ID on a personnel record can now be changed, if needed, without needing to create a new personnel record
- Vaccinations with a mfg expiration date prior to the date administered may now be recorded accurately (in the case one is ever accidentally given). CHD users will have the option to show expired vaccine when selecting inventory to reduce. Expired vaccinations are already automatically marked as invalid, per previous update.
- Upload Data Quality Report now exists to provide more detail to uploading/interop organizations on the data sent to Florida SHOTS. Report can be used to examine errors and warnings received across multiple days and submissions.
- Form 680 updated to not default to any parent or guardian, though selection is still required
- Aging Vaccine Report values are now numeric, rather than text, to allow for easier use with Excel calculations
- Vaccine Utilization Report criteria now defaults to no efforts selected
- Vaccine Utilization Report now shows state imm id for each patient
- Religious Exemption Report issues with incorrectly calculated totals have been corrected. “By Issuer” report no longer will show percentages, only total number issued.
