

## Summary of Changes to Florida SHOTS Release 2020.1

Changes made since last update (Release 2020.0.1, fully deployed as of 3/13/20):

- Modifications made to 680 creation to clarify use of Part A Code 1 vs Part A Code 8 and to not allow both to be selected.
- Disable fields on Transaction Statistics while a request is running and prevent resetting results page during retrieval.
- Updated Transaction Statistics to show HMS web service transactions, email on HMS web service error
- FLSHOTS Mobile Patient Viewer
- Update to 680 rules on how the TDAP date is populated
- Other minor internal system updates to maintain the system or correct minor issues

Changes made with the current release:

- Updates to improve auto-merge efficiency
- Information on clinics that have been defined under a service site now present on Site Information page (by clicking “Site Info” button when viewing/updating a service site)
- Updates to Reminder Recall:
  - Added age range to criteria page so entire population doesn’t have to be scanned unless needed
  - Previously generated results are allowed to be reviewed even after the day they were created, up to 7 days from creation date
  - Remove “Include patients with...” address option on results page
  - Add email addresses in results and “EMAIL” as a contact attempt method
- Search for Form 680 option now shows 680 type detail in search results
- Show selected Trans Stats category when 'Retrieving Data...' is shown
- Algorithms updated to better handle multiple shots covering the same antigen given on same day, plus update to address an issue of incorrect forecast dates in certain circumstances such as with the “HepB-CpG risk 3-dose series” schedule.
- Updates to Meaningful Use Stage 3 to allow for status of “Actively Engaged”, meaning VXU or QBP messages have been sent, but not yet both
- Removed outdated User Guide and WBT content and associated links
